

For the protection of all involved at any Thompson Kart Raceway event, new COVID-19 protection precautions have been implemented.

NEW PROCEDURES ARE NOW IN PLACE

Because of changes in insurance rules (non COVID19) and the health and wellbeing of our members and staff (COVID19), there will be changes to the way we need to operate.

ARRIVAL AND REGISTRATION

- Due to the changes in insurance and COVID19, we will now be distributing the pit passes and registering drivers upon your arrival at the track. This is a common practice at several facilities that some of our traveling racers are already used to.
- All vehicles must stop at the gate house.
- If there is a vehicle ahead of you, you must wait to exit your vehicle until you reach the gate house.
- Be sure that your paperwork (found at the Thompson Kart Raceway website or Facebook page) is filled out completely and signed prior to your arrival at the track.
 - Pit Waiver
 - Covid-19 Waiver and self-assessment
 - Membership form (if not already completed)
- When you are the front vehicle in line, one adult member of the vehicle may proceed to the attendant. **YOU MUST BE WEARING YOUR FACE MASK.** We **will not** register you without a face mask.
- The attendant will check your paperwork, record your wristband number, and register your driver(s).
- You will then pay the attendant (**NO CASH, CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS ONLY PLEASE**).
- Return to your vehicle, enter the facility, and GO HAVE FUN!

COVID-19 PROCEDURES ONCE INSIDE THE RACE FACILITY

- Masks are required at all times when social distancing cannot be maintained, such as, but not limited to: registration, concessions, scales on the grid, etc.
- It is a requirement that we maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet at all times.
- Max occupancy per pit area is 10 people.
- It is important to maintain good hygiene and clean hands often.
- Portable toilets are fitted with hand wash stations.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at several locations throughout the facility.

Please note that people not following these guidelines may be asked to leave the facility without a refund.
